

Bonnie Brown Memorial Scholarship

The **Bonnie Brown Memorial Scholarship** fund was started in 1995 in honor of the groundbreaking work of past chapter President, Bonnie Brown, in the area of payroll education. Bonnie dedicated herself to the education of Payroll Professionals by starting the Dallas Chapter Education Department prior to her untimely death.

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a deserving member, who has 5 years or less of payroll experience and has not obtained their FPC or CPP designation. This scholarship offers \$1000 of DAPA education classes as well as a copy of the 2018 Payroll Source. The scholarship must be used in the following year and the recipient of this award cannot have previously won a DAPA scholarship. All registrations will be completed by the Education or Associate Education Director. The Bonnie Brown Memorial Scholarship is open to all active members who meet this criteria and are in good standing with the Dallas Chapter American Payroll Association. Board Directors and Officers are not eligible for this scholarship award.
